

Opening a Prairie Community Bank account online is easy and convenient.

The application takes about 10 minutes - but if you need more time, you can save your progress so you don't lose your information and can pick right back up where you left off. Existing customers who wish to open a Personal Account online must be at least 18 years of age and possess a government-issued picture ID from Illinois or Wisconsin. Additionally, customers will also need their personal contact information and social security number in order to complete the application.

The FDIC (Federal Deposit Insurance Corporation) is an independent agency of the United States government that protects bank depositors against the loss of their insured deposits.

How does the FDIC protect you? FDIC deposit insurance protects bank customers in the that an FDIC-insured event depository institution fails. Bank customers don't need purchase deposit insurance; it is automatic for deposit anv account opened at an FDICinsured bank. Deposits insured up to at least \$250,000 per depositor.
